## 1 AN ACT concerning

## Public Information Act – List of Contact Information for Governmental Unit Representatives

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain governmental entities to identify a representative  $\mathbf{5}$ who a member of the public should contact to request a public record, maintain 6 certain contact information, post the information on the unit's Web site or keep the 7 information in a certain place, and annually update the information and submit it to the Office of the Attorney General; requiring the Office to post certain information 8 9 on the Office's Web site and include certain information in a certain manual; and generally relating to a list of contact information for representatives of governmental 10 units that maintain public records. 11

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1 (5) ANNUALLY SUBMIT THE CONTACT INFORMATION MAINTAINED 2 UNDER ITEM (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

- 3 (B) THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL:
- 4 (1) POST THE CONTACT INFORMATION SUBMITTED UNDER 5 SUBSECTION (A)(5) OF THIS SECTION IN A USER-FRIENDLY FORMAT ON THE WEB 6 SITE OF THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL; AND
- 7 (2) INCLUDE THE CONTACT INFORMATION SUBMITTED UNDER
  8 SUBSECTION (A)(5) OF THIS SECTION IN ANY PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT MANUAL
  9 PUBLISHED BY THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2015.
