4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain governmental entities to identify a representative 5 who a member of the public should contact to request a public record, maintain certain contact information, post the information on the unit's Web site or keep the 6 7 information in a certain place, and annually update the information and submit it to 8 the Office of the Attorney General; requiring the Office to post certain information 9 on the Office's Web site and include certain information in a certain manual; and 10 generally relating to a list of contact information for representatives of governmental units that maintain public records. 11
