Worcester County - Alcoholic Beverages - Craft Distillery License

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class 9 craft distillery license in Worcester County; 4 setting a license fee; providing that the State Comptroller issue the Class 9 license 5 only to a holder of a Class D beer, wine and liquor license in the County for use on 6 the premises for which the Class D license was issued; authorizing a holder of a Class 7 9 license to establish and operate a plant for distilling and bottling brandy, rum, 8 whiskey, alcohol, and neutral spirits under certain circumstances; authorizing a 9 holder of Class 9 license to acquire bulk alcoholic beverages, to store, sell, and deliver product, to conduct guided tours, and to serve a certain number of samples to certain 10 11 persons; prohibiting a holder of a Class 9 license from taking certain actions; 12 requiring a holder of a Class 9 license to abide by all trade practice restrictions 13 applicable to distilleries; requiring a holder of a Class 9 license to take certain actions 14 to distill more than a certain amount of gallonage; and generally relating to Class 9 15 distillery licenses in Worcester County.
