- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 18
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**
- 4-401. 21
- 22Except as provided in § 4–402 of this subtitle, and subject to the venue provisions of
- 23 Title 6 of this article, the District Court has exclusive original civil jurisdiction in:



- 1 (17) An action for damages for a dishonored check or other instrument under 2 Title 15, Subtitle 8 of the Commercial Law Article, regardless of the amount in controversy;
- 3 **[and]**
- 4 (18) A civil action for an injunction or for a civil penalty for a violation of § 5 8–605(f) of the Transportation Article; **AND**
- 6 (19) A CIVIL ACTION FOR FIRST-PARTY MOTOR VEHICLE BENEFITS
  7 FOR UNINSURED MOTORIST COVERAGE UNDER TITLE 19, SUBTITLE 5 OF THE
  8 INSURANCE ARTICLE IN WHICH:
- 9 (I) THE DAMAGES CLAIMED DO NOT EXCEED \$50,000, 10 EXCLUSIVE OF PREJUDGMENT OR POSTJUDGMENT INTEREST, COSTS, AND 11 ATTORNEY'S FEES, IF ATTORNEY'S FEES ARE RECOVERABLE BY LAW OR CONTRACT; 12 AND
- 13 (II) THE AMOUNT OF THE UNINSURED MOTORIST'S LIABILITY 14 INSURANCE COVERAGE DOES NOT EXCEED \$30,000.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any case filed before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2015.
