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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore Police Department – Reporting on Community Policing**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City to report annually  
4 certain information concerning the Baltimore Police Department to the Mayor and  
5 City Council of Baltimore and the members of the Baltimore City Delegation to the  
6 General Assembly; requiring the report to be made available on the Department’s  
7 Web site; and generally relating to the Baltimore Police Department.

11 Annotated Code of Maryland

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Public Safety**

16 **3–510.**

17 **(A) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE POLICE COMMISSIONER**  
18 **OF BALTIMORE CITY SHALL REPORT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CONCERNING**  
19 **THE BALTIMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF**  
20 **BALTIMORE AND THE MEMBERS OF THE BALTIMORE CITY DELEGATION TO THE**  
21 **GENERAL ASSEMBLY:**

22 **(1) AS OF DECEMBER 1 OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR:**

5                   (III)   THE NUMBER OF SWORN FEMALE POLICE OFFICERS IN THE

8 DEPARTMENT WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF BALTIMORE CITY; AND

10                  (I)     THE NUMBER OF RECRUITING EVENTS THE DEPARTMENT  
11 SPONSORED OR PARTICIPATED IN IN BALTIMORE CITY;

12                  (II)    THE NUMBER OF ENCOUNTERS BY OFFICERS WITH  
13 RESIDENTS THAT RESULTED IN CIVILIAN INJURIES;

14                  (III)   THE NUMBER OF OFFICERS WHO WERE SUSPENDED WITH  
15 PAY;

16                  (IV)   THE NUMBER OF OFFICERS WHO WERE SUSPENDED  
17 WITHOUT PAY;

18                  (V)     THE PERCENTAGE OF PATROL OFFICERS WHO WERE  
19 ASSIGNED TO NEIGHBORHOOD PATROLS;

20                  (VI)    THE NUMBER OF SCHOOL VISITS MADE BY NEIGHBORHOOD  
21 PATROL OFFICERS;

22                  (VII)   THE NUMBER OF RECREATION, COMMUNITY, AND SENIOR  
23 CENTER VISITS MADE BY NEIGHBORHOOD PATROL OFFICERS;

24                  (VIII)   THE NUMBER OF YOUTH UNDER THE AGE OF 25 YEARS  
25 REFERRED TO INTERVENTION PROGRAMS BY OFFICERS; AND

26                  (IX)    THE NUMBER OF COMMUNITY-BASED TOWN HALL  
27 MEETINGS CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

28                  (B)     THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION  
29 SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC ON THE DEPARTMENT'S WEB SITE.

1           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
2   October 1, 2015.
