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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Historic Motor Vehicles – Minimum Age**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the age that a motor vehicle must attain in order to be  
4 eligible for registration as a historic motor vehicle; providing for the prospective  
5 application of this Act; and generally relating to historic motor vehicles.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Transportation**

14 13–936.

15 (a) In this section, “historic motor vehicle” means a motor vehicle, including a  
16 passenger vehicle, motorcycle, or truck that:

17 (1) Is at least [20] ~~25~~ **30** years old;

1           (2)    Has not been substantially altered from the manufacturer's original  
2 design; and

3           (3)    Meets criteria contained in regulations adopted by the Administration.

4           (b)    In this section, "historic motor vehicle" does not include a vehicle that has been  
5 remanufactured or reconstructed as a replica of an original vehicle.

6           (c)    If registered with the Administration under this section, every historic motor  
7 vehicle is a Class L (historic) vehicle.

8           (d)    Except as provided in subsection (i) of this section, for each Class L (historic)  
9 vehicle, the annual registration fee is \$25.50.

10          (e)    In applying for registration of a historic motor vehicle under this section, the  
11 owner of the vehicle shall submit with the application a certification that the vehicle for  
12 which the application is made:

13               (1)    Will be maintained for use in exhibitions, club activities, parades, tours,  
14 occasional transportation, and similar uses; and

15               (2)    Will not be used:

16                     (i)    For general daily transportation; or

17                     (ii)   Primarily for the transportation of passengers or property on  
18 highways.

19          (f)    Except as provided in § 13–936.1 of this subtitle, on registration of a vehicle  
20 under this section, the Administration shall issue a special, historic motor vehicle  
21 registration plate of the size and design that the Administration determines.

22          (g)    Unless the presence of the equipment was specifically required by a statute of  
23 this State as a condition of sale when the vehicle was manufactured, the presence of any  
24 specific equipment is not required for the operation of a vehicle registered under this  
25 section.

26          (h)    A vehicle registered under this section is exempt from any statute that  
27 requires periodic vehicle inspections or that requires the use and inspection of emission  
28 controls.

29               (i)    (1)    For a motor vehicle manufactured at least 60 years prior to the current  
30 model year, there is a onetime registration fee of \$50.00.

31                     (2)    Registration of a motor vehicle manufactured under this subsection is  
32 not transferable to a subsequent owner.

1        SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to  
2 apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or  
3 application to any historic motor vehicle registered before the effective date of this Act.

4        SECTION ~~2.~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
5 ~~October~~ June 1, 2015.
