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1 (l) (1) In Allegany County, Baltimore City, Caroline County, Carroll County, 2 Cecil County, Charles County, Frederick County, Harford County, **KENT COUNTY**, Queen 3 Anne's County, Somerset County, Talbot County, Washington County, Wicomico County, 4 and Worcester County, the local board consists of five regular members.

5 (2) Three regular members shall be of the majority party, and two regular 6 members shall be of the principal minority party.

7 (3) (i) If a vacancy occurs on the local board, the Governor shall appoint 8 an eligible person from the same political party as the predecessor member to fill the 9 vacancy in accordance with subsection (g) of this section for the remainder of the unexpired 10 term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(ii) An appointment made while the Senate of Maryland is not in
session shall be considered temporary until the appointee is confirmed by the Senate.

14 (b) (2) (ii) [3. In Kent County, a substitute member shall be paid at least 15 \$50 for each meeting that the substitute member attends.]

16 SECTION 2.
