SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

(a) (1) A licensee licensed under this article, or any employee of the licensee,
may not sell or furnish any alcoholic beverages at any time:

1 (i) To a person under 21 years of age for the underage person's own 2 use or for the use of any other person; or

3 (ii) To any person who, at the time of the sale, or delivery, is visibly 4 under the influence of any alcoholic beverage.

6 (d) (1) For any violation that is cause for suspension under the alcoholic 7 beverage laws affecting Baltimore City, the Baltimore City Board of License 8 Commissioners may:

9 [(1)] (I) [For] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 10 SUBSECTION, FOR a first offense, impose a fine of not more than \$500 or suspend the 11 license or both; or

12 [(2)] (II) For any subsequent offense, impose a fine of not more than 13 \$3,000 or suspend the license or both.

14 (2) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE OF SELLING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO A 15 PERSON UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE, THE BOARD MAY IMPOSE A FINE OF NOT MORE 16 THAN \$1,000 OR SUSPEND THE LICENSE OR BOTH.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2015.
