 SUBTITLE 16. SYNTHETIC INFILL TURF FIELDS.

- 19 THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A FACILITY WITH A SYNTHETIC INFILL TURF 20 FIELD SHALL POST A SIGN IN A CONSPICUOUS LOCATION THAT IS VISIBLE TO THE 21 INDIVIDUALS WHO USE THE FIELD AND STATES:
