4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Capital Grant Program for Local School Systems With Significant Enrollment Growth or Relocatable Classrooms; providing for the purpose $\mathbf{5}$ 6 of the Program and requiring the Interagency Committee on Public School 7 Construction to implement and administer the Program; specifying certain 8 requirements for grants awarded under the Program; requiring the Interagency 9 Committee to award certain grants to certain county boards of education under the 10 Program; requiring the Interagency Committee to develop certain eligibility 11 requirements and certain procedures and processes for grants awarded under the 12Program; requiring the Interagency Committee to adopt certain procedures; requiring the Governor, beginning in a certain fiscal year, to provide a certain 1314 amount of money in the State budget for the Program each fiscal year; specifying 15that funding provided under the Program is supplemental to public school construction funding from other sources; defining certain terms; and generally 16 17relating to the Capital Grant Program for Local School Systems With Significant 18 Enrollment Growth or Relocatable Classrooms.
