- 4 FOR the purpose of expanding the membership of the Board of License Commissioners of 5 Prince George's County; requiring the Governor to appoint a certain number of 6 commissioners from certain political parties; requiring the Governor to appoint at 7 least a certain number of commissioners from each legislative district in the county; 8 requiring certain central committees to designate each commissioner serving on a 9 certain date as an eligible candidate, with a certain exception; providing for 10 staggered terms of office; requiring that not more than a certain number of 11 appointees belong to the same political party; authorizing certain central committees 12 to submit lists of eligible candidates for commissioner to the Governor on or after a 13 certain date; providing for the effective dates of this Act; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to the Board of License Commissioners of Prince 14 15 George's County.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 22 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 1 (2) (i) The Board of License Commissioners consists of [5] NINE 2 members.
- 3 (ii) [The] SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS 4 PARAGRAPH, THE Governor shall appoint [4 of the 5 Commissioners]:
- 5 **EIGHT OF THE NINE COMMISSIONERS** from the political party obtaining the highest number of votes in the last gubernatorial general election in the county[, and the Governor shall appoint 1 Commissioner]; AND
- 8 **2. ONE COMMISSIONER** from the political party obtaining 9 the next highest number of votes in the county election.
- 10 (III) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT AT LEAST ONE 11 COMMISSIONER FROM EACH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.
- [(iii)] (IV) 1. [Before] SUBJECT TO SUBSUBPARAGRAPH 2 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, BEFORE making the appointments or filling any vacancy, the Governor shall request the central committees for Prince George's County representing each of the [2] TWO leading political parties of the State to designate at least [4] FOUR eligible candidates for each position[; and the].
- 17 2. EACH CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL DESIGNATE EACH 18 COMMISSIONER SERVING ON JUNE 30, 2015, AS AN ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE, UNLESS TWO OR MORE COMMISSIONERS RESIDE IN THE SAME LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT, IN 19 20 CASE THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL DESIGNATE ONLY 21 COMMISSIONER AS AN ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE FROM THAT LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT.
- 3. The Governor shall appoint one of the persons so designated unless in [his] THE GOVERNOR'S judgment all of the persons are unfit or incompetent, in which case [he] THE GOVERNOR shall file a written statement to that effect with the Secretary of State.
- 4. The statement FILED UNDER SUBSUBPARAGRAPH 3 OF
 THIS SUBPARAGRAPH shall set forth the facts and the grounds [therefor] FOR FILING
 THE STATEMENT and shall call upon the committees for Prince George's County for
 another list of [6] SIX names for each position to be filled, from which list and the original
 list the Governor shall make the appointments.
 - (3) (I) The term of a [member] COMMISSIONER is 3 years.

- 1 (II) The terms of the [members] COMMISSIONERS are staggered as required by the terms provided for [members of the Board] COMMISSIONERS on July 1, 3 [1985] 2015.

 4 (4) Not more than [4] EIGHT of the appointees shall belong to the same political party.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the central committees for Prince George's County representing each of the two leading political parties of the State may submit their list of eligible candidates for commissioner to the Governor on or after June 1, 2015.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the commissioners serving on July 1, 2015, end as follows:
- 12 (1) three commissioners on June 30, 2016;
 - (2) three commissioners on June 30, 2017; and
- 14 (3) three commissioners on June 30, 2018.

- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect June 1, 2015.
- SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in Section 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
