- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring local law enforcement agencies to provide the Department of 4 State Police with certain information on officer-involved deaths and deaths in the 5 line of duty; requiring the Department to report annually certain information on 6 officer-involved deaths and deaths in the line of duty to the General Assembly; 7 requiring the Department to adopt certain procedures for reporting certain deaths; 8 requiring the Department to report certain information on officer-involved deaths 9 and deaths in the line of duty to the General Assembly by a certain date; defining 10 certain terms; and generally relating to the reporting of officer-involved deaths and 11 deaths in the line of duty.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Public Safety
- 20 **2-315.**
- 21 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 22 INDICATED.

- 1 (2) "DEATH IN THE LINE OF DUTY" MEANS THE DEATH OF A LAW
- 2 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OCCURRING WHILE THE OFFICER IS ACTING IN THE
- 3 OFFICER'S OFFICIAL CAPACITY WHILE ON DUTY OR WHILE THE OFFICER IS OFF
- 4 DUTY, BUT PERFORMING ACTIVITIES THAT ARE WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE
- 5 OFFICER'S OFFICIAL DUTIES.
- 6 (3) "Law enforcement agency" has the meaning stated in § 7 2–101 of this title.
- 8 (4) (I) "LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" HAS THE MEANING STATED 9 IN § 3–101 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 10 (II) "LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" INCLUDES A PRIVATE
- 11 SECURITY OFFICER PERFORMING DUTIES AS PART OF A CONTRACT WITH A LAW
- 12 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.
- 13 (5) "OFFICER-INVOLVED DEATH" MEANS THE DEATH OF AN
- 14 INDIVIDUAL RESULTING DIRECTLY FROM AN ACT OR OMISSION OF A LAW
- 15 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHILE THE OFFICER IS ON DUTY OR WHILE THE OFFICER
- 16 IS OFF DUTY, BUT PERFORMING ACTIVITIES THAT ARE WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE
- 17 OFFICER'S OFFICIAL DUTIES.
- 18 (B) EVERY YEAR, BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2016, EACH LOCAL LAW
- 19 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT WITH INFORMATION
- 20 ABOUT EACH OFFICER-INVOLVED DEATH AND DEATH IN THE LINE OF DUTY THAT
- 21 INVOLVES A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER EMPLOYED BY THE AGENCY, TO INCLUDE:
- 22 (1) THE AGE, GENDER, GENDER IDENTITY, SEXUAL ORIENTATION,
- 23 ETHNICITY, RACE, AND LANGUAGE PREFERENCE OF A DECEASED INDIVIDUAL WHO
- 24 IS NOT A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER;
- 25 (2) THE AGE, GENDER, GENDER IDENTITY, SEXUAL ORIENTATION,
- 26 ETHNICITY, RACE, AND LANGUAGE PREFERENCE OF THE OFFICER INVOLVED;
- 27 (3) THE MANNER OF THE OFFICER OR DECEASED INDIVIDUAL'S
- 28 **DEATH; AND**
- 29 (4) THE DATE, TIME, AND LOCATION OF THE DEATH; AND
- 30 (5) THE DISPOSITION OF ANY INVESTIGATION, INQUIRY, OR
- 31 DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDING RESULTING FROM THE DEATH.

- 1 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT PROCEDURES FOR THE COLLECTION 2 AND ANALYSIS OF THE INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS 3 SECTION.
- 4 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ANALYZE AND DISSEMINATE THE 5 INFORMATION PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 6 (E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE 7 INCIDENCE OF OFFICER-INVOLVED DEATHS AND DEATHS IN THE LINE OF DUTY IN 8 THE STATE TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE 9 STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30 OF EACH YEAR.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- 11 (a) On or before October 15, 2016, the Department of State Police shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on the number of officer—involved deaths and deaths in the line of duty that occurred during the previous 10 calendar years.
- 15 (b) The report shall include information as required by § 2–315(b) of the Public Safety Article as enacted by this Act.
- 17 (c) Each local law enforcement agency shall provide the Department of State 18 Police with the information described in § 2–315(b) of the Public Safety Article as enacted 19 by this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
