3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission to issue 4 a temporary video lottery employee license to an applicant for a video lottery employee license under certain circumstances; requiring that the applicant make 5 6 certain acknowledgements in writing; providing that the temporary license may not 7 be issued to certain applicants; providing that the temporary license expires after a 8 certain number of days; authorizing the Commission to extend the temporary license 9 for a certain number of days; authorizing the Commission to terminate the 10 temporary license without a hearing under certain circumstances; requiring an 11 applicant to surrender a certain temporary license identification and cease certain 12 work if the application for a certain license is denied; and generally relating to the 13 issuance of video lottery employee licenses.
