A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County - Solicitation and Collection of Money or Donations From Occupants of Vehicles - Adoption of a Permit Program

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Anne Arundel County Council or the governing body of $\mathbf{5}$ a municipal corporation in Anne Arundel County to enact a permit program to allow 6 individuals who are at least a certain age and representatives of a certain 7 organization who are at least a certain age to solicit money or donations from the 8 occupant of a vehicle by standing in a roadway, a median divider, or an intersection; 9 requiring an applicant for a permit to submit proof of a certain safety plan; providing 10 that a permit be effective only for a certain time period; providing that an individual 11 or a certain organization may obtain only a certain number of permits per calendar 12year; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the solicitation and collection 13 of money or donations from occupants of vehicles in Anne Arundel County.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

1 (2) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "QUALIFIED ORGANIZATION" MEANS A FIRE 2 COMPANY OR BONA FIDE RELIGIOUS, FRATERNAL, CIVIC, WAR VETERANS', OR 3 CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION.

4 (3) (i) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS 5 SUBSECTION, A person may not stand in a highway to:

6 1. Solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant 7 of a vehicle; or

Rights-of-way, roadway surfaces, roadway subgrades, 11 shoulders, median dividers, drainage facilities and structures, related stormwater 12 management facilities and structures, roadway cuts, roadway fills, guardrails, bridges, 13 highway grade separation structures, railroad grade separations, tunnels, overpasses, 14 underpasses, interchanges, entrance plazas, approaches, and other structures forming an 15 integral part of a street, road, or highway, including bicycle and walking paths; and

16 2. Any other property acquired for the construction, 17 operation, or use of the highway.

(4) 18 **(I)** THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY COUNCIL OR THE GOVERNING BODY OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY MAY, 19 20BY APPROPRIATE RESOLUTION OR ORDINANCE, ENACT A PERMIT PROGRAM TO ALLOW INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD AND REPRESENTATIVES OF 2122**QUALIFIED ORGANIZATIONS WHO ARE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD TO SOLICIT MONEY** 23OR DONATIONS FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE BY STANDING IN A ROADWAY, A MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR AN INTERSECTION IN THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL 2425CORPORATION.

(II) IF THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY COUNCIL OR THE
GOVERNING BODY OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY
ENACTS A RESOLUTION OR AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PERMIT PROGRAM
AUTHORIZED BY THIS PARAGRAPH, THE RESOLUTION OR ORDINANCE SHALL:

301. REQUIRE AN APPLICANT FOR A PERMIT TO SUBMIT31PROOF THAT THE INDIVIDUAL OR QUALIFIED ORGANIZATION HAS A PLAN FOR32SAFELY SOLICITING MONEY OR DONATIONS FROM THE PROPOSED LOCATION;

332.PROVIDE THAT A PERMIT IS EFFECTIVE FOR A34PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 7 CALENDAR DAYS; AND

13.ALLOW AN INDIVIDUAL OR A QUALIFIED2ORGANIZATION TO OBTAIN ONLY ONE PERMIT IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY OR THE3MUNICIPAL CORPORATION PER CALENDAR YEAR.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2015.
