A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Highway Administration – Signs Along State Highways – Public Libraries**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Highway Administration to place a sign along a
4 certain State highway indicating the presence of a public library if there is a public
5 library within a certain distance of an exit ramp on the highway; and generally
6 relating to informational signs along State highways.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Transportation**

15 8–605.

16 **(G) IF THERE IS A PUBLIC LIBRARY WITHIN ONE–HALF MILE OF AN EXIT**
17 **RAMP ON A CONTROLLED ACCESS STATE HIGHWAY, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL**
18 **PLACE A SIGN ALONG THE HIGHWAY INDICATING THE PRESENCE OF THE PUBLIC**
19 **LIBRARY.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2015.
