# SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article – Transportation

15 8–605.

16 (G) IF THERE IS A PUBLIC LIBRARY WITHIN ONE-HALF MILE OF AN EXIT 17 RAMP ON A CONTROLLED ACCESS STATE HIGHWAY, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL 18 PLACE A SIGN ALONG THE HIGHWAY INDICATING THE PRESENCE OF THE PUBLIC 19 LIBRARY.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2015.
