A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Department of Health and Mental Hygiene – Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic Demonstration Program – Grant Application

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to apply to the federal Department of Health and Human Services for a planning grant for a certain purpose; and generally relating to the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and the federal demonstration program for the establishment of certified community behavioral health clinics.

9 Preamble

WHEREAS, The federal Protecting Access to Medicare Act, passed by the United States Congress in 2014, includes provisions of the Excellence in Mental Health Act that establish a 2–year demonstration program to increase access to community mental health and substance use treatment services while improving Medicaid reimbursement for these services; and

WHEREAS, The demonstration program provides for the establishment of certified community behavioral health clinics to serve individuals with serious mental illnesses and substance use disorders that provide intensive, person—centered, multidisciplinary, evidence—based screening, assessment, diagnostic, treatment, prevention, and wellness services; and

WHEREAS, The federal Department of Health and Human Services will select up to eight states to participate in the demonstration program; and

WHEREAS, Maryland is well positioned to become one of the eight demonstration states as it has a strong network of community behavioral health providers ready to meet the standards specified in the federal legislation; and WHEREAS, The federal legislation appropriates \$25,000,000 for the purpose of awarding planning grants in January 2016 to states that seek to participate in the demonstration program; and

WHEREAS, A state is required to apply for and receive a planning grant to be eligible for selection as a demonstration state; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall apply to the federal Department of Health and Human Services for a planning grant to have the State selected as a demonstration state for the establishment of certified community behavioral health clinics under the federal Protecting Access to Medicare Act.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2015.
