## SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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## Article – Real Property

15 14-117.

16 (j-1) (1) A contract for the initial sale of a new home, as defined in the Maryland 17 Home Builder Registration Act, shall be contingent on the purchaser obtaining a written 18 commitment for a loan secured by the property [, unless the contract contains a provision 19 expressly stating that it is not contingent].

20 (2) [If the contract is contingent on the purchaser obtaining a written 21 commitment for a loan secured by the property, the] **THE** contract shall state the maximum 22 loan interest rate the purchaser is obligated to accept.
