## State Finance and Procurement - One Maryland Blue Ribbon Commission

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the One Maryland Blue Ribbon Commission; providing for 4 the composition, chair, and staffing of the Commission; prohibiting a member of the 5 Commission from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing 6 reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Commission to review the current 7 State procurement process and develop policy recommendations to ensure greater 8 participation of businesses located in the State in State contracting; requiring the 9 Commission to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and 10 11 generally relating to the One Maryland Blue Ribbon Commission.
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 13 That:
- 14 (a) There is a One Maryland Blue Ribbon Commission.
- 15 (b) The Commission consists of the following members:
- 16 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of 17 the Senate:
- 18 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of 19 the House of Delegates; and
- 20 (3) the following representatives appointed by the Governor:
- 21 (i) five regional business owner representatives, one each from the 22 Western, Capital, Southern, Central, and Eastern Shore regions of the State;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2015. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 2016, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
