1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education and Workforce Training Coordinating Council for Correctional**
3 **Institutions – Name Change**

4 FOR the purpose of changing the name of the Education and Workforce Training
5 Coordinating Council for Correctional Institutions to the Correctional Education
6 Council; and generally relating to changing the name of the Education and
7 Workforce Training Coordinating Council for Correctional Institutions.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Article – Labor and Employment
10 Section 11–901(a), 11–902(a), and 11–906(a)
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (2008 Replacement Volume and 2014 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Labor and Employment**

16 11–901.

17 (a) There is [an Education and Workforce Training Coordinating Council for
18 Correctional Institutions] **A CORRECTIONAL EDUCATION COUNCIL** under the

4 (a) The [Education and Workforce Training Coordinating Council for
5 Correctional Institutions] **CORRECTIONAL EDUCATION COUNCIL** shall develop and
6 recommend an educational and workforce training program for each correctional
7 institution in the Division of Correction. The programs shall meet the special needs and
8 circumstances of the inmates in each correctional institution.

9 11-906.

10 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Patuxent Institution is a
11 correctional institution within the Division of Correction and under the jurisdiction of the
12 [Education and Workforce Training Coordinating Council for Correctional Institutions]
13 **CORRECTIONAL EDUCATION COUNCIL** for the funding of educational and workforce
14 skills training programs only.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
16 1, 2015.
