1 (2) (i) "Alcoholic beverages" means alcohol, brandy, whiskey, rum, gin, 2 cordial, beer, ale, porter, stout, wine, cider, and any other spirituous, vinous, malt or 3 fermented liquor, liquid, or compound, by whatever name called, which contains, except as 4 provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, one-half of one percent or more of alcohol 5 by volume, which is fit for beverage purposes.

6 (ii) "Alcoholic beverages" does not include a confectionery food 7 product that contains up to 5 percent of alcohol by volume and is regulated by the 8 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene under § 21–209 of the Health – General Article.

10 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES 11 THAT ARE SOLD IN POWDER OR CRYSTALLINE FORM FOR DIRECT USE OR USE IN 12 COMBINATION WITH WATER OR ANY OTHER SUBSTANCE.

13(B)(1)APERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A14MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 17 1, 2015. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June 18 30, 2016, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be 19 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
