3 FOR the purpose of clarifying that if more than one stockholder, partner, member, or 4 employee of a certain entity engaged in practicing law enters an appearance in an 5 action or a case, the clerk of the circuit court may collect only one appearance fee per entity; clarifying that, if more than one employee of a certain governmental entity 6 7 enters an appearance in an action or a case, the clerk of the circuit court may collect 8 only one appearance fee per governmental entity; and generally relating to the collection of appearance fees. 9
