A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Workers' Compensation – Children's Scholarship Fund – Establishment

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Workers' Compensation Children's Scholarship Fund; 4 requiring the Workers' Compensation Commission to impose, in addition to the $\mathbf{5}$ payment of certain compensation, a certain assessment against an employer or its 6 insurer for each award of compensation for permanent total disability against the 7 employer; providing that the assessments shall be paid into the Fund; establishing 8 the Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of the Fund; requiring 9 the Joint Committee on Workers' Compensation Benefit and Insurance Oversight to administer the Fund; requiring the State Treasurer to hold the Fund and the 1011 Comptroller to account for the Fund; specifying the contents of the Fund; specifying 12the purposes for which the Fund may be used; providing for the investment of money 13in and expenditures from the Fund; authorizing the Committee to award certain 14scholarship assistance to individuals who meet certain requirements; requiring the 15Committee, in consultation with a certain organization, to establish certain policies 16and procedures for the administration of the scholarship assistance; authorizing the 17Committee to consider the recommendations of a certain entity in awarding 18 scholarship assistance under a certain provision of this Act; providing that an award 19or a denial of scholarship assistance under a certain provision of this Act is in the 20sole and exclusive discretion of the Committee; requiring the Commission, at the 21 discretion of the Committee, to pay awards of scholarship assistance directly to a 22certain educational institution for a certain purpose; exempting the Fund from a 23certain provision of law requiring interest on State money in special funds to accrue 24to the General Fund of the State; defining certain terms; and generally relating to 25the Workers' Compensation Children's Scholarship Fund.

7 (A) THERE IS A WORKERS' COMPENSATION CHILDREN'S SCHOLARSHIP 8 FUND.

9 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE 10 TO INDIVIDUALS WHOSE PARENTS OR GUARDIANS HAVE RECEIVED COMPENSATION 11 FOR PERMANENT TOTAL DISABILITY UNDER THE MARYLAND WORKERS' 12 COMPENSATION ACT.

13 (C) THE COMMITTEE SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

14 (D) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT 15 SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

16 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, 17 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

18 (F) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:

19 (1) REVENUE DISTRIBUTED TO THE FUND UNDER § 9–751 OF THIS 20 ARTICLE;

- 21 (2) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;
- 22 (3) INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND; AND
- 23(4) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR24THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
- 25 (G) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY FOR:

26 (1) AWARDING SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE TO STUDENTS WHO MEET 27 THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 10–403(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND 1 (2) ADMINISTERING THE FUND AND SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE 2 UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

3 (H) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND 4 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.

8 (A) THE COMMITTEE MAY AWARD SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE FROM THE 9 FUND TO AN INDIVIDUAL:

10 (1) WHOSE PARENT OR GUARDIAN WAS DETERMINED BY THE 11 COMMISSION TO HAVE SUFFERED A PERMANENT TOTAL DISABILITY COMPENSABLE 12 UNDER THE MARYLAND WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT; AND

- 14 (I) IS UNDER THE AGE OF 26 YEARS;

20 (B) IN CONSULTATION WITH KIDS' CHANCE OF MARYLAND, INC., THE 21 COMMITTEE SHALL ESTABLISH POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE 22 ADMINISTRATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE, INCLUDING APPLICATION 23 FORMS FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE AWARDED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF 24 THIS SECTION.

(C) IN AWARDING SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF
THIS SECTION, THE COMMITTEE MAY CONSIDER THE RECOMMENDATIONS, IF ANY,
