1 AN ACT concerning

2 Kent County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class B Wine Shop and Lounge License

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class B wine shop and lounge license in Kent County; specifying that the license authorizes the holder to sell wine for consumption on and 4 $\mathbf{5}$ off the premises and to sell or serve certain foods; providing that the license holder 6 is not subject to any requirement regarding the percentage of average daily receipts 7 derived from the sale of food; allowing an individual under the legal drinking age to 8 enter the licensed premises if accompanied by an individual who is of the legal 9 drinking age; setting an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Kent County. 10

1 (E) AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE LEGAL DRINKING AGE MAY ENTER THE 2 LICENSED PREMISES IF ACCOMPANIED BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS OF THE LEGAL 3 DRINKING AGE.

4 (F) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$300.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 1, 2015.
