CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Kent County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class B Wine Shop and Lounge License**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class B wine shop and lounge license in Kent County;
4 specifying that the license authorizes the holder to sell wine for consumption on and
5 off the premises and to sell or serve certain foods; providing that the license holder
6 is not subject to any requirement regarding the percentage of average daily receipts
7 derived from the sale of food; allowing an individual under the legal drinking age to
8 enter the licensed premises ~~if accompanied by an individual who is of the legal~~
9 ~~drinking age~~; setting an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic
10 beverages in Kent County.

12 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

13 Section 4–301 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 3. Class B Wine Licenses”

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

19 **SUBTITLE 3. CLASS B WINE LICENSES.**

20 **4–301.**

- 2 **(B) THERE IS A CLASS B WINE SHOP AND LOUNGE LICENSE.**
- 3 **(C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO:**
- 4 **(1) SELL WINE FOR CONSUMPTION ON AND OFF THE PREMISES; AND**
- 5 **(2) SELL OR SERVE:**
- 6 **(I) BREAD AND OTHER BAKED GOODS;**
- 7 **(II) CHILI;**
- 8 **(III) CHOCOLATE;**
- 9 **(IV) CRACKERS;**
- 10 **(V) CURED MEAT;**
- 11 **(VI) FRUITS (WHOLE AND CUT);**
- 12 **(VII) SALADS AND VEGETABLES (WHOLE AND CUT);**
- 13 **(VIII) HARD AND SOFT CHEESE (WHOLE AND CUT);**
- 14 **(IX) ICE CREAM;**
- 15 **(X) JELLY;**
- 16 **(XI) JAM;**
- 17 **(XII) VINEGAR;**
- 18 **(XIII) PIZZA;**
- 19 **(XIV) PREPACKAGED SANDWICHES AND OTHER PREPACKAGED**
20 **FOODS READY TO BE EATEN;**
- 21 **(XV) SOUP; AND**
- 22 **(XVI) CONDIMENTS.**

1 (D) THE LICENSE HOLDER IS NOT SUBJECT TO ANY REQUIREMENT
2 REGARDING THE PERCENTAGE OF AVERAGE DAILY RECEIPTS DERIVED FROM THE
3 SALE OF FOOD.

4 (E) AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE LEGAL DRINKING AGE MAY ENTER THE
5 LICENSED PREMISES ~~IF ACCOMPANIED BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS OF THE LEGAL~~
6 ~~DRINKING AGE.~~

7 (F) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$300.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
9 1, 2015.
