AN ACT concerning

## Program Open Space - Baltimore City - Purchase Talbot Road Property

FOR the purpose of requiring the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City to use a portion of certain funding authorized for certain grants for the purpose of acquiring property at a certain location in Baltimore City; providing that Baltimore City may not use certain funds for any purpose until certain property is acquired; requiring the Department of Natural Resources to determine if a certain requirement is met; and generally relating to a requirement that the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City use certain funding for purchasing certain property.

Preamble
WHEREAS, Several parcels of land located in the 2400 and 2500 blocks of Talbot Road in the Windsor Hills neighborhood of Baltimore City are available for purchase; and

WHEREAS, The Gwynns Falls/Leakin Park and the associated conservation trails are an important and essential feature of the Windsor Hills neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, Now is the opportune time for Baltimore City to purchase at a reasonable price additional land to protect and enhance the Gwynns Falls/Leakin Park and its associated conservation trails; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Natural Resources

5-903.
(a) (2) (ii) At least $\$ 1,500,000$ of the State's share of funds available under subparagraph (i)1A of this paragraph for this program shall be utilized to make grants to Baltimore City for projects which meet park purposes. The grants shall be in addition to any funds Baltimore City is eligible to receive under subsection (b) of this section, and may be used for acquisition or development. In order for Baltimore City to be eligible for a State grant, the Department shall review projects or land to be acquired within Baltimore City, and upon the Department's recommendation, the Board of Public Works may approve projects and land including the cost. Title to the land shall be in the name of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City. The State is not responsible for costs involved in the development or maintenance of the land.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for fiscal year 2016 the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City shall use a portion of the Program Open Space funds authorized for grants to Baltimore City under § 5-903(a)(2)(ii) of the Natural Resources Article for the purpose of acquiring property located in the 2400 and 2500 blocks of Talbot Road in Baltimore City for inclusion into the Gwynns Falls/Leakin Park system.
(2) Except as provided in paragraph (1) of this section, for fiscal year 2016 the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City may not use the Program Open Space funds authorized for grants to Baltimore City under §5-903(a)(2)(ii) of the Natural Resources Article for any purpose until the acquisition of the property required under paragraph (1) of this section is complete.
(3) The Department of Natural Resources shall determine if the requirement under paragraph (1) of this section is met.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2015.
