FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor's Workforce Investment Board to coordinate
with the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, health occupations boards, and
certain other parties to establish a workgroup to study access to obstetric services in
the State by developing a certain mechanism to evaluate certain factors; requiring
the workgroup to report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before
a certain date each year; and generally relating to the Governor's Workforce
Investment Board and a workgroup to study access to obstetric services.

3 (1) THE NUMBER AND GEOGRAPHIC LOCATIONS OF OBSTETRICAL 4 HEALTH CARE WORKERS IN THE STATE;

- 5 (2) PRACTICE PATTERNS;
- 6 (3) PROVIDER PREFERENCES; AND

7 (4) OTHER FACTORS DETERMINED TO BE RELEVANT BY THE 8 WORKGROUP.

9 (B) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE WORKGROUP SHALL 10 SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE 11 STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE SENATE EDUCATION, HEALTH, AND 12 ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE HEALTH AND 13 GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS COMMITTEE ON THE FINDINGS OF THE BOARD.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June1, 2015.
