- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (a) Subject to § 5-402 of this title, an individual who has filed a certificate of
- 16 candidacy may withdraw the candidacy by filing a certificate of withdrawal on the form
- 17 prescribed by the State Board within [2] 7 days after the filing date established under §
- 18 5–303 of this title.
- 19 (b) An individual who has filed a certificate of candidacy for the special election
- 20 to fill a vacancy for Representative in Congress may withdraw the certificate on the
- 21 prescribed form within 2 days after the filing date established in the proclamation issued
- 22 by the Governor.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
