- WHEREAS, K9 dogs are loyal, loving, and devoted, and have been placed in harm's
- 18 way, making the ultimate sacrifice by laying down their lives for their human partners;
- 19 and
- WHEREAS, Thousands of dogs have served with honor, dignity, and valor through
- 21 the history of our country's birth and growth and have been employed by the United States
- 22 military from World War I to present conflicts; and
- WHEREAS, The official K9 Corps was created on March 13, 1942; and

- WHEREAS, Federal, State, and local law enforcement agencies have established K9
 Corps units where dogs are trained for specialized activities such as bomb detection, drug
 interdiction, search and rescue, border patrol, customs, and secret service; and
- WHEREAS, Recognition of K9 Corps dogs is appropriate to honor their service to protect our communities, State, and country; now, therefore,
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 7–402 through 7–413, respectively, of Article – General Provisions of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–403 through 7–414, respectively.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 12 Article General Provisions
- 13 **7–402.**
- THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM MARCH 13 AS K9 VETERANS DAY.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
