## Public Schools - Thirsty Kids Act

3 FOR the purpose of requiring each public school to make available free, unlimited, potable drinking water for each student throughout the school day, and to include a reusable 4 5 water bottle on the school supplies list for each student in kindergarten through 6 grade 12, and to provide certain cups for drinking water in certain locations; 7 requiring the State Department of Education to encourage each county board to develop a plan to promote the consumption of drinking water, the use of reusable 8 9 water bottles, and weekly cleaning of reusable water bottles; and generally relating 10 to drinking water in public schools.
