## **SENATE BILL 326**

1 (b) A permit may be renewed for successive periods of 3 years each if, at the time 2 of an application for renewal, the applicant possesses the qualifications for the issuance of 3 a permit and pays the renewal fee stated in this subtitle.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2015.
