# SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

15 14-602.

(a) [Beginning July 1, 2012, a] A unit shall structure procurement procedures,
consistent with the purposes of this subtitle, to try to achieve an overall minimum of [0.5%]
5% of the unit's total dollar value of procurement contracts to be made directly or indirectly
with veteran–owned small business enterprises.

20 (b) Solicitation documents shall establish the expected degree of veteran–owned 21 small business enterprise participation based, in part, on:

22 (1) the potential subcontract opportunities available in the procurement 23 contract; and

1 (2) the availability of veteran–owned small business enterprises to respond 2 competitively to the potential subcontract opportunities.

3 (c) The provisions of this subtitle do not apply to a unit's procurement procedures 4 to the extent that any unit determines that those provisions are in conflict with an 5 applicable federal program.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2015.
