# Electric Companies – Installation of Solar Electric Generating Facility – New Interconnection Agreement

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a person who is negotiating a certain solar installation and interconnection contract with a <del>customer to contact the customer's</del> certain  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 customer–generator to submit to the customer–generator's electric company to 7 determine whether the electric company is accepting new interconnection agreements in the customer's property area and to notify the customer of this 8 9 determination before the contract is executed a certain application; allowing a 10 certain person to accept a certain payment before receiving a certain approval; 11 prohibiting a certain person to begin a certain installation under certain circumstances; requiring a certain person to notify a certain customer-generator of 12 13a certain decision; requiring a certain person to refund a certain payment under certain circumstances; requiring an electric company, on request of a certain person, 14 to provide certain information regarding the ability of the distribution system to 15accept a new interconnection process a certain application and notify the person of a 16 certain decision in accordance with a certain process and time frame specified in 1718 certain regulations; and generally relating to a new interconnection agreement for 19the installation of a solar electric generating facility.

 THIS SUBSECTION.

1 (B) ON REQUEST OF A PERSON UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS 2 SECTION, AN ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL <del>PROVIDE INFORMATION REGARDING THE</del> 3 <del>ABILITY OF A SPECIFIC LOCATION ON THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM TO ACCEPT A NEW</del> 4 <del>INTERCONNECTION</del> <u>PROCESS AN APPLICATION SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION</u> 5 (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION AND NOTIFY THE PERSON WHETHER THE APPLICATION IS 6 <u>APPROVED OR DISAPPROVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH A PROCESS AND TIME FRAME</u> 7 <u>SPECIFIED IN REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION</u>.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2015.
