1 AN ACT concerning

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- Public Service Commission Community Solar Projects or Virtual Net Energy
  Metering Study
- FOR the purpose of requiring the Public Service Commission, in consultation with the 4 5 Maryland Energy Administration, to convene a stakeholder workgroup to study and 6 make recommendations on the establishment of advisability of establishing a 7 program to allow certain customers to participate in certain community solar 8 projects or virtual net energy metering; requiring the workgroup to examine certain 9 matters relating to the establishment of advisability of establishing a certain 10 program; requiring the Commission to report to the General Assembly on or before 11 a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to a 12 study by the Public Service Commission on the establishment of advisability of 13 establishing a program for community solar projects or virtual net energy metering.
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 15 That:
  - (a) The Public Service Commission, in consultation with the Maryland Energy Administration, shall convene a stakeholder workgroup to study and make recommendations on the establishment of advisability of establishing a program to allow residential customers who are unable to install solar panels on their own property to participate in community solar projects or virtual net energy metering through which a customer may subscribe to the output of the solar installation and obtain the benefits of solar generation.
