functions; prohibiting the executive director from directly conducting certain
investigations or inspections; and generally relating to the State Board of Morticians
and Funeral Directors, staff, and the designation and duties of the executive director.

## SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 3 (3) (I) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL MANAGE THE STAFF OF 4 THE BOARD AND PERFORM ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS TO CARRY OUT THE 5 POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD AS PROVIDED FOR UNDER THIS TITLE.

6 (II) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MAY NOT DIRECTLY CONDUCT 7 INVESTIGATIONS OR INSPECTIONS ON BEHALF OF THE BOARD.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 9 1, 2015.
