- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (1) on or before June 30, 2011, is subject to the Alternate Contributory
- 22 Pension Selection;
 - (2) (i) is separated from employment for 4 years or less; [or]

1 2 3	(ii) 1. is separated from employment for more than 4 years for military service that meets the requirements of the federal Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act; and
4 5 6	2. resumes employment within 1 year of leaving military service in a position that is included in the Employees' Pension System or Teachers' Pension System; OR
7 8	(III) 1. IS SEPARATED FROM EMPLOYMENT FOR MORE THAN 4 YEARS; AND

19 20 21 22	(c) On or before October 1, 2012, and each October 1 through October 1, 2016, the Board of Trustees shall submit a report in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article to the Joint Committee on Pensions that provides the number of members described under subsection (a) of this section who were:
23 24	(1) rehired in the preceding fiscal year into a position included in the Employees' Pension System or Teachers' Pension System; and
