A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Developmental Disabilities Administration and Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Services – Military Families

4 FOR the purpose of providing that certain dependents who are determined eligible to $\mathbf{5}$ receive services from the Developmental Disabilities Administration shall retain 6 eligibility for the services under certain circumstances; requiring the Administration 7 to allow certain dependents to remain on a certain waiting list under certain 8 circumstances; requiring the Administration to resume certain services for certain 9 dependents under certain circumstances; providing that certain dependents who are 10 determined eligible to receive certain services from the Maryland Medical Assistance 11 Program shall retain eligibility for the services under certain circumstances; 12requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to allow certain dependents 13 to remain on a certain waiting list under certain circumstances; requiring the 14 Department to resume certain services for certain dependents under certain 15circumstances; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the eligibility for and receipt of Developmental Disabilities Administration and Maryland Medical 1617Assistance Program services by dependents of military service members.

1 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "LEGAL RESIDENT" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO 2 MAINTAINS THE STATE AS THE INDIVIDUAL'S PRINCIPAL ESTABLISHMENT, HOME OF 3 RECORD, OR PERMANENT HOME AND TO WHERE, WHENEVER ABSENT DUE TO 4 MILITARY OBLIGATION, THE INDIVIDUAL INTENDS TO RETURN.

5 (B) A DEPENDENT OF A LEGAL RESIDENT OF THE STATE WHO IS 6 DETERMINED ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE SERVICES FROM THE ADMINISTRATION UNDER 7 THIS TITLE SHALL RETAIN ELIGIBILITY FOR THE SERVICES:

8 (1) REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE LEGAL RESIDENT LEAVES THE 9 STATE DUE TO THE LEGAL RESIDENT'S MILITARY ASSIGNMENT OUTSIDE THE STATE; 10 AND

(2) IF THE DEPENDENT IS OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE FOR THE SERVICES.

12 (C) IF A DEPENDENT OF A LEGAL RESIDENT IS ON A WAITING LIST FOR 13 SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED UNDER THIS TITLE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL 14 ALLOW THE DEPENDENT TO REMAIN ON THE WAITING LIST FOR SERVICES WHILE 15 THE LEGAL RESIDENT IS OUTSIDE THE STATE DUE TO THE LEGAL RESIDENT'S 16 MILITARY ASSIGNMENT OUTSIDE THE STATE.

17 (D) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL RESUME SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER 18 THIS TITLE TO A DEPENDENT OF A LEGAL RESIDENT WHO RESIDES WITH THE LEGAL 19 RESIDENT WHILE THE LEGAL RESIDENT IS OUTSIDE THE STATE DUE TO THE LEGAL 20 RESIDENT'S MILITARY ASSIGNMENT OUTSIDE THE STATE:

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(1) ON THE RELOCATION OF THE DEPENDENT TO THE STATE; AND

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(2) IF A REQUEST FOR SERVICES IS MADE.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "LEGAL RESIDENT" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO
MAINTAINS THE STATE AS THE INDIVIDUAL'S PRINCIPAL ESTABLISHMENT, HOME OF
RECORD, OR PERMANENT HOME AND TO WHERE, WHENEVER ABSENT DUE TO
MILITARY OBLIGATION, THE INDIVIDUAL INTENDS TO RETURN.

(B) A DEPENDENT OF A LEGAL RESIDENT OF THE STATE WHO IS
 DETERMINED ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE HOME- AND COMMUNITY-BASED WAIVER
 SERVICES OR OTHER WAIVER SERVICES FROM THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS TITLE
 SHALL RETAIN ELIGIBILITY FOR THE SERVICES:

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1(1)REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE LEGAL RESIDENT LEAVES THE2STATE DUE TO THE LEGAL RESIDENT'S MILITARY ASSIGNMENT OUTSIDE THE STATE;3AND

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(2) IF THE DEPENDENT IS OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE FOR THE SERVICES.

5 (C) IF A DEPENDENT OF A LEGAL RESIDENT IS ON A WAITING LIST FOR 6 HOME-AND COMMUNITY-BASED WAIVER SERVICES OR OTHER WAIVER SERVICES TO 7 BE PROVIDED UNDER THIS TITLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ALLOW THE 8 DEPENDENT TO REMAIN ON THE WAITING LIST FOR SERVICES WHILE THE LEGAL 9 RESIDENT IS OUTSIDE THE STATE DUE TO THE LEGAL RESIDENT'S MILITARY 10 ASSIGNMENT OUTSIDE THE STATE.

11 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL RESUME SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER THIS 12 TITLE TO A DEPENDENT WHO RESIDES WITH THE LEGAL RESIDENT WHILE THE 13 LEGAL RESIDENT IS OUTSIDE THE STATE DUE TO THE LEGAL RESIDENT'S MILITARY 14 ASSIGNMENT OUTSIDE THE STATE:

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- (1) ON THE RELOCATION OF THE DEPENDENT TO THE STATE; AND
- 16 (2) IF A REQUEST FOR SERVICES IS MADE.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2015.
