## 2 Real Estate Brokers and Salespersons - Continuing Education - Requirements

- FOR the purpose of repealing a provision of law that requires certain licensed real estate brokers, associate real estate brokers, and real estate salespersons to complete fewer overall clock hours of continuing education instruction than the number generally required during certain licensing periods; requiring that certain mandated subject matter for continuing education courses be taken by a licensee each licensing period; making conforming changes; and generally relating to continuing education
