## SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

- 16 (a) This section applies only in Washington County.
- 17 (b) A special wine tasting license (WTL) may be issued only to a holder of a Class 18 A (off-sale) beer, wine and liquor license [or a Class B (on-off sale) beer, wine and liquor 19 license].
- 20 (c) The annual license fee is \$200, in addition to the annual license fee of a Class 21 A (off–sale) beer, wine and liquor license.

1 (d) The Board of License Commissioners may issue a special wine tasting license 2 (WTL) to permit on-premises consumption of wine for tasting or sampling purposes only.

3 (e) The holder of a special wine tasting license may not charge for the wine tasting 4 or sampling.

5 (f) The license is effective for use no more than 12 days in a licensing year. The 6 licensee shall notify the Board in writing at least 10 days in advance of any scheduled 7 tasting date.

8 (g) Servings are limited to no more than 2 ounces of any one wine to any one 9 customer.

10 (h) The Board may adopt regulations to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2015.
