- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 17 **16–508.1**.
- 18 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WASHINGTON COUNTY.
- 19 **(B)** A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE OR OF ANY REGULATION ADOPTED 20 UNDER THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE EXPUNGED BY THE BOARD OF LICENSE 21 COMMISSIONERS AFTER 5 YEARS FROM THE DATE THE VIOLATION OCCURRED.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 2015.
