Alcoholic Beverages – Allegany County – Class B–MB (Micro–Brewery/Restaurant) License

- 4 FOR the purpose of creating in Allegany County a Class B-MB (micro-brewery/restaurant) $\mathbf{5}$ license; specifying that the Board of License Commissioners may issue a Class 6 B-MB license to a holder of a Class 7 manufacturer's license; providing that the 7 Class B-MB license authorizes the license holder to sell at retail beer and light wine 8 by the drink or by the bottle and liquor by the drink only for consumption on the 9 licensed premises, including in certain areas; providing that the Class B-MB license authorizes the license holder to sell at retail beer and light wine by the bottle for 10 11 off-premises consumption; specifying certain days and hours of sale for the 12Class B-MB license; specifying a certain annual fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Allegany County. 13

2 (a) (1) A Class B beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued by the license 3 issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located, and the license 4 authorizes its holder to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at retail at any hotel 5 or restaurant at the place described, for consumption on the premises or elsewhere, or as 6 provided in this section.

(b) (1) The provisions of this subsection apply only in Allegany County.

8 (b-1) (9) (I) THERE IS A SPECIAL CLASS B-MB 9 (MICRO-BREWERY/RESTAURANT) LICENSE.
