## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Wage and Hour Law – Tip Credit – Repeal**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the authority of an employer to include as part of an  
4 employee's wage a certain amount to represent the tips of the employee; and  
5 generally relating to the tip credit authorized under the Maryland Wage and Hour  
6 Law.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Labor and Employment**

15 **[3–419.**

16 (a) (1) This section applies to each employee who:

17 (i) is engaged in an occupation in which the employee customarily  
18 and regularly receives more than \$30 each month in tips;

19 (ii) has been informed by the employer about the provisions of this  
20 section; and

21 (iii) has kept all of the tips that the employee received.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1                   (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1)(iii) of this subsection, this section does  
2 not prohibit the pooling of tips.

3                   (b) Subject to the limitations in this section, an employer may include, as part of  
4 the wage of an employee to whom this section applies:

5                   (1) an amount that the employer sets to represent the tips of the employee;  
6 or

7                   (2) if the employee or representative of the employee satisfies the  
8 Commissioner that the employee received a lesser amount in tips, the lesser amount.

9                   (c) The tip credit amount that the employer may include under subsection (b) of  
10 this section may not exceed the minimum wage established under § 3–413 of this subtitle  
11 for the employee less \$3.63.]

12                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
13 1, 2015.
