1 (3) (I) "MORTUARY SCIENCE PRACTITIONER" MEANS A PERSON 2 WHO IS LICENSED BY THE STATE AS A FUNERAL DIRECTOR, MORTICIAN, OR 3 SURVIVING SPOUSE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE MORTUARY SCIENCE.

4 (II) "MORTUARY SCIENCE PRACTITIONER" INCLUDES A 5 PERSON ACTING UNDER THE DIRECTION OF A PERSON WHO IS LICENSED BY THE 6 STATE AS A FUNERAL DIRECTOR, MORTICIAN, OR SURVIVING SPOUSE LICENSEE TO 7 PRACTICE MORTUARY SCIENCE.

(4) "POLICE OFFICER" MEANS A MEMBER OF:

9 (I) A POLICE FORCE OF THE STATE; OR

10(II) A POLICE FORCE OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL11CORPORATION OF THE STATE.

12 **(B) (1)** ON REQUEST OF A MORTUARY SCIENCE PRACTITIONER AND 13 SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH **(2)** OF THIS SUBSECTION, A POLICE OFFICER CALLED TO A 14 RESIDENCE WHERE AN INDIVIDUAL HAS DIED SHALL REMAIN AT THE RESIDENCE:

15(I)UNTIL THE BODY IS REMOVED FROM THE RESIDENCE BY16THE MORTUARY SCIENCE PRACTITIONER OR MEDICAL EXAMINER; OR

(II) FOR AT LEAST 90 MINUTES.

18 (2) A POLICE OFFICER MAY LEAVE A RESIDENCE BEFORE THE TIME 19 PERIOD REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION HAS ELAPSED IF 20 THE POLICE OFFICER RECEIVES A CALL THAT REQUIRES THE POLICE OFFICER TO 21 RESPOND TO A MATTER THAT IS A HIGHER PRIORITY THAN REMAINING AT THE 22 RESIDENCE.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 2015.
