SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Correctional Services

16 (a) Except as otherwise provided, the provisions of this subtitle supersede any 17 inconsistent provisions of any other State law, including § 11–106 of the State Personnel 18 and Pensions Article, that conflict with this subtitle to the extent of the conflict.

19 (b) This subtitle does not limit the authority of the appointing authority to 20 regulate the competent and effective operation and management of a State correctional 21 facility by reasonable means including the transfer and reassignment of employees if:

- (1) that action is not punitive in nature; and

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2015.
