A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Health Occupations – Professional Counselors and Therapists – Provisional Licenses

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists $\mathbf{5}$ to issue a certain provisional license to an individual to practice clinical alcohol and 6 drug counseling, clinical marriage and family therapy, clinical professional art 7 therapy, or clinical professional counseling under certain circumstances; 8 establishing certain qualifications and application requirements for the provisional 9 license; requiring the Board to issue a certain provisional license under certain circumstances; providing that a certain provisional license authorizes the holder to 10 11 practice certain counseling or therapy; providing for the term of the provisional 12license; providing that a provisional license may not be renewed; and generally 13 relating to provisional licenses and professional counselors and therapists.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this section **OR § 17–301.1** 3 **OF THIS SUBTITLE**, an individual may not practice, attempt to practice, or offer to practice 4 clinical alcohol and drug counseling, clinical marriage and family therapy, clinical 5 professional art therapy, or clinical professional counseling in the State unless licensed by 6 the Board.

7 (b) Subject to the regulations of the Board, subsection (a) of this section does not 8 apply to:

9 (1) A student working under the supervision of a licensed mental health 10 care provider while pursuing a supervised course of study in counseling that the Board 11 approves as qualifying training and experience under this title; or

12 (2) An individual who, in accordance with § 17–406 of this title, is working 13 as a trainee under the supervision of a licensed clinical alcohol and drug counselor or 14 another health care provider licensed or certified under this article and approved by the 15 Board while fulfilling the experiential or course of study requirements under § 17–302 of 16 this subtitle or § 17–403 or § 17–404 of this title.

17 (c) This subtitle may not be construed to limit the scope of practice of any 18 individual who is duly licensed under this article.

(A) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A PROVISIONAL LICENSE TO AN INDIVIDUAL TO
 PRACTICE CLINICAL ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELING, CLINICAL MARRIAGE AND
 FAMILY THERAPY, CLINICAL PROFESSIONAL ART THERAPY, OR CLINICAL
 PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING FOR A PERIOD OF 1 YEAR WHILE THE INDIVIDUAL IS
 COMPLETING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR FULL LICENSURE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

25 (B) (1) TO QUALIFY FOR A PROVISIONAL LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION, 26 AN APPLICANT SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION.

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THE APPLICANT SHALL:

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- (I) **BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER; AND**
- 29 (II) BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD.

30 (3) AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION FOR A PROVISIONAL LICENSE, THE 31 APPLICANT SHALL: (I) HOLD A VALID LICENSE IN ANOTHER STATE TO PRACTICE
 CLINICAL ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELING, CLINICAL MARRIAGE AND FAMILY
 THERAPY, CLINICAL PROFESSIONAL ART THERAPY, OR CLINICAL PROFESSIONAL
 COUNSELING; AND
 (II) HAVE HELD THE LICENSE IN THE OTHER STATE FOR AT
 LEAST 2 YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE OF APPLICATION.

7 (4) THE APPLICANT SHALL DEMONSTRATE PROGRESS TOWARD FULL
8 LICENSURE IN THIS STATE BY MEETING ONE OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS
9 AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION:

10(I) THE APPLICANT IS ENROLLED IN A REGIONALLY11ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY IN A PROGRAM OF STUDY THAT WILL12COMPLETE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR FULL LICENSURE IN THIS STATE;

13 (II) THE APPLICANT IS REGISTERED TO TAKE THE 14 NATIONAL-LEVEL EXAMINATION REQUIRED BY THE BOARD FOR FULL LICENSURE 15 IN THIS STATE AND THE STATE LAW TEST;

16 (III) THE APPLICANT HAS TAKEN THE NATIONAL-LEVEL 17 EXAMINATION REQUIRED BY THE BOARD FOR FULL LICENSURE IN THIS STATE AND 18 THE STATE LAW TEST AND IS WAITING FOR THE RESULTS; OR

19 (IV) THE APPLICANT HAS PASSED THE NATIONAL-LEVEL 20 EXAMINATION REQUIRED BY THE BOARD FOR FULL LICENSURE IN THIS STATE AND 21 IS REGISTERED TO TAKE THE STATE LAW TEST.

- 22 (C) TO APPLY FOR A PROVISIONAL LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:
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(1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THE BOARD REQUIRES;

24 (2) PAY TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION FEE SET BY THE BOARD; 25 AND

(3) SUBMIT TO THE BOARD TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION
 FROM A CLINICAL ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELOR, CLINICAL MARRIAGE AND
 FAMILY THERAPIST, CLINICAL PROFESSIONAL ART THERAPIST, OR CLINICAL
 PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR WHO:

30(I) HOLDS A LICENSE IN THE PRACTICE FOR WHICH THE31APPLICANT SEEKS A PROVISIONAL LICENSE; AND

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1	(II) 1. IS LICENSED IN THIS STATE; OR

6 7 8 9	(E) A PROVISIONAL LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO PRACTICE AS A CLINICAL ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELOR, CLINICAL MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST, CLINICAL PROFESSIONAL ART THERAPIST, OR CLINICAL PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR WHILE THE PROVISIONAL LICENSE IS IN EFFECT.
10	(F) (1) A PROVISIONAL LICENSE EXPIRES 1 YEAR AFTER IT IS ISSUED.
11	(2) A PROVISIONAL LICENSE MAY NOT BE RENEWED.
