- 2 (A) (1) BEFORE MEETING IN AN OPEN SESSION, A PUBLIC BODY SHALL 3 PROVIDE TO THE PUBLIC AN AGENDA:
- 4 (I) CONTAINING AVAILABLE INFORMATION REGARDING 5 MATTERS TO BE DISCUSSED AT THE PORTION OF THE MEETING THAT IS OPEN; AND
- 6 (II) INDICATING WHETHER THE PUBLIC BODY EXPECTS TO 7 CLOSE ANY PORTION OF THE MEETING IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 3–305 OF THIS 8 SUBTITLE.
- 9 (2) If AN AGENDA HAS BEEN DETERMINED AT THE TIME THE PUBLIC BODY GIVES NOTICE OF THE MEETING UNDER § 3–302 OF THIS SUBTITLE THE PUBLIC BODY SHALL PROVIDE THE AGENDA AT THE SAME TIME IT PROVIDES NOTICE OF THE MEETING.
- 13 (3) IF AN AGENDA HAS NOT BEEN DETERMINED AT THE TIME THE

- 22 (2) THE METHOD A PUBLIC BODY USES FOR PROVIDING AN AGENDA 23 MAY BE DIFFERENT FROM THE METHOD A PUBLIC BODY USES FOR GIVING NOTICE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
