3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor annually to proclaim a certain day as Thurgood
4 Marshall Day; requiring the proclamation to urge certain organizations to observe
5 Thurgood Marshall Day properly; and generally relating to Thurgood Marshall Day.

18 WHEREAS, Thurgood Marshall was born in Baltimore City on July 2, 1908; and

1 WHEREAS, Thurgood Marshall was one of the first African American lawyers in the
2 State of Maryland; and

3 WHEREAS, Thurgood Marshall was a prominent figure in the legal fight for justice
4 under the law for all people; and

5 WHEREAS, In 1967, Thurgood Marshall became the first African American to be
6 appointed to the United States Supreme Court; now, therefore,

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
8 That Section(s) 7-411 through 7-413, respectively, of Article – General Provisions of the
9 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7-412 through 7-414,
10 respectively.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read
12 as follows:

13 **Article – General Provisions**

14 **7-411.**

15 **(A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM JULY 2 AS THURGOOD**
16 **MARSHALL DAY.**

17 **(B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL**
18 **ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE THURGOOD MARSHALL DAY PROPERLY.**

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
20 1, 2015.
