- 21 (a) (1) A licensee licensed under this article, or any employee of the licensee,
- 22 may not sell or furnish any alcoholic beverages at any time:
- 23 (i) To a person under 21 years of age for the underage person's own

- 4 (d) **(1)** For any violation that is cause for suspension under the alcoholic 5 beverage laws affecting Baltimore City, the Baltimore City Board of License 6 Commissioners may:
- [(1)] (I) [For] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, FOR a first offense, impose a fine of not more than \$500 or suspend the license or both; or
- 10 **[(2)] (II)** For any subsequent offense, impose a fine of not more than \$3,000 or suspend the license or both.
- 12 (2) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE OF SELLING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO A
 13 PERSON UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE, THE BOARD MAY IMPOSE A FINE OF NOT MORE
 14 THAN \$1,000 OR SUSPEND THE LICENSE OR BOTH.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2015.
