

Chapter 196

(Senate Bill 744)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2011 – Montgomery County – Water Park at Bohrer Park

FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2011 to provide that certain grants for the Water Park at Bohrer Park may not terminate before June 1, 2016; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2011.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
Chapter 396 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2011

ZA03 LOCAL HOUSE OF DELEGATES INITIATIVES

(AT)	Water Park at Bohrer Park. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$125,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gaithersburg for the repair, reconstruction, renovation, and refurbishment of the water park at Bohrer Park, located in Gaithersburg. NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 1(7) OF THIS ACT, THIS GRANT MAY NOT TERMINATE BEFORE JUNE 1, 2016

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
