As well as, with many faith-based, public, private & nonprofit organizations, engaged in supporting and strengthening underserved

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Harambee House (Casa De Ayuda) is an outreach program of Mount Olive CDC. It will provide emergency assistance, referrals, and a variety of support services and programs. Working in collaboration with the Light House Shelter, we will provide regular pantry support and bag lunches. A small food pantry and clothes closet will be established. Working in collaboration with other faith based and community organizations, the Harambee House will assist veterans and other underserved persons, by providing direct or referral based support, as well as faith based counseling and encouragement.

Community meeting and classroom space will be available to support local faith based and community organizations. Working in conjunction with the Alliance for the Chesapeake Bay, Anne Arundel Community College, Walter Mills Elementary and other NGO's, a variety of adult education and student support services will be provided (tutoring, SAT prep, internships, and summer employment support, etc.). English and/or Spanish as a second language classes will be provided to help bridge the cultural divide within the greater community.
